

Registering New Students

Students may register for grades 7–12 at Springhill Jr. /Sr. High School. New students registering must comply with the following:

- Students who are age 17 years or younger, must be accompanied by a Custodial Parent or Legal Guardian and must have both their Birth Certificate and their Health Card in order to register for school in Nova Scotia. Documentation of Custodial arrangements may be requested as well.
- Be ready to show a copy of the latest report card from their previous school. Parents / Guardians will be asked to sign a Request for Records to be sent to the previous school.
- Students are asked to contact the school at least one day prior to their intended start date. This includes registration for the beginning of the school year. International Students are asked to please contact the school to make an appointment, at least one week before starting school for scheduling purposes.
- Students transferring from another school within Chignecto–Central Regional School Board must complete an Application for Student Transfer through their current school principal.
